



Client Safety

Client safety is of upmost importance to me!! I want you to feel safe and to make the session as relaxing as possible. This is why I have introduced the following steps, inline with Government guidelines:

Client Safety Guidelines

Our Cleaning Policy.

I already take steps to ensure my studio is clean with regular vacuuming, using disinfectant on surfaces and floors and washing all blankets, clothes and props before they are used by another client. I have upped the anti with this however, and any screen, surface, chair, bin, bathroom handle and door handle is disinfected prior to and after a client session.

If your session is at the cabin studio.

For the safety of ourselves and clients, there will no longer be access to the main house. Access will be limited to the studio and bathroom only.

1. Upton entering the studio I would ask that you remove your shoes and place them in a designated shoe tray, use of alcohol gel to sanitise hands, and face masks and gloves will be available if required (although this is now legally optional).

2. I have seats designated for you whilst your consultation takes place prior to your session.

3. Extra hands sanitising will be done by the photographer prior to and during the session. I also have additional PPE which includes gloves, face mask and disposable aprons (depending on the type of session and will discuss this prior to the session starting).
 4. Due to space and to restrict the number of people in the studio, I will only allow up to 4 people in the studio and they must all be from the same household.
 5. Fabrics and outfits will be cleaned between clients - So they will be freshly cleaned for you and your family. Every fabric, wrap, blanket and outfit that a baby touches is washed.
 6. There will be only 1 session per day to eliminate the risk of contact with others and I now allow 24-48 hours between clients.
 7. The studio will be cleaned after each client - I will clean, sanitise and wipe down all of our equipment, props, backdrops, surfaces and anything that is touched during a session is cleaned and sanitised.
 8. I will no longer be offering refreshments and will ask that you bring a bottled drink and any snacks with you. I will have a kettle but this can only be used to heat bottles; I no longer provide the water to make up your bottles.
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If your session is outdoors.

1. Similarly to a studio session, I will keep a 2 meter distance from you.
2. Extra hands sanitising will be done for the photographer prior to and during the session. I also have additional PPE which includes gloves, face mask and disposable aprons if needed.
3. If any fabrics, outfits or props are used, they will be cleaned between clients - So they will be freshly cleaned for you and your family. Every fabric, wrap, blanket and outfit that a baby touches is washed.

Sickness Policy.

We would ask that if baby or someone in your family is sick, that you contact the studio and we will reschedule for you. (This is a rule I've always had in place anyway!) Similarly, if I or a member of my household are sick then, I will contact you and reschedule for another time.
